## EMERGENCIES

When disaster strikes, Save the Children does whatever it takes to save children's lives.

Wherever disaster strikes, they are there – saving lives. Teams do whatever it takes to reach children in desperate need. In 2015, Save the Children responded to 76 emergencies, delivering life-saving food, water, healthcare, protection and education to three million children.

# Child Refugee Crisis Appeal



Thousands of child refugees and their families are making dangerous journeys to Europe.

They urgently need care and protection.

Save the Children are providing food, water and shelter along the routes refugees take.



Children like four-month-old Yasmin\* face winter temperatures that could fall as low as  $-20^{\circ}\text{C}$  as they travel through Serbia in search of safety in Europe. "In Syria, it doesn't get this cold," her mother Rabia\* told us. "We have never been this cold." -

## Rula's story



When an airstrike hit Rula's school in Syria, her friends were killed, but she survived.

Her family sought safety in northern Syria. For three years they were trapped in their home because it was too dangerous to go out. They had no electricity and little food or water.

Rula and her family escaped to Greece in a boat with 50 other refugees. “I know we were lucky because last week some people drowned,” she told team.

Save the Children created safe spaces where child refugees, like Rula, can learn and play.



# How is Save the Children helping?

- Save the Children provides children and families with food and clean water, as well as medicine, shelter and winter clothes. They support healthcare facilities and schools, and give children safe spaces to play and learn.
