Take the time to research different Roman mosaics on the internet where there are also many designs available. Make sure you come up with a design before you start. 

PROJECT 4

PROJECT 5

Create a poster to inform people of the inventions that the Romans introduced to Britain. For each invention, include a description about how it helped Britain. For examples, the Romans invented baths to help us wash!
