PROJECT 3

Design a Round House



Your task is to collect household items to use to construct a 3D model of a Celtic round house. Think about how you can make it look as authentic (real) as possible.

Things you could use: cardboard tubes (kitchen rolls), toothpicks, lolly sticks, paper mache or anything else you can find.



PROJECT 1

A Day in the life of Queen Boudicca

Your task is to write a diary entry of the day that Queen Boudicca leads the people of Iceni to fight the Romans. Think about how she might be feeling, what armour she needs and what she actually did on that day. Remember to write in the first person!



PROJECT 4

Use the computer to research and create a fact file about one of the Celtic gods. You could create a PowerPoint presentation to share with the class. Think about the presentation of your work- try to use font, pictures and animations to make it look appealing.



PROJECT 2

Celtic Patterns

The Celts liked to gift certain items to their gods. Design a decorative shield and choose a medium (paint, pencils, pastels etc.) to colour it in. Ensure that your shield has a Celtic-inspired design on it.



PROJECT 5

Research the types of foods that the Celts would have eaten. They were excellent farmers and had plenty of food including cheese, meat and vegetables. Make a meal that is inspired by the Celts, write the recipe and take some pictures of what you produce.
