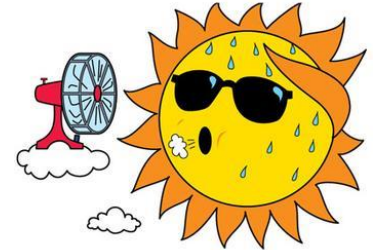

Dear Parents/Carers,

R.E: Hot Weather

As you may be aware, we are expecting very high temperatures this week and we would like to ensure your child is well protected from the heat whilst in school.



Before School:

- Parents are encouraged to ensure students apply sunscreen before they come to school, and to bring this with them in order to re-apply it when necessary (**A medical form will need to be completed at main reception**).
- It is essential that your child has a water bottle in school, if your child does not have a school water bottle they can buy one for £2.
- Students should also bring a sun hat which covers their head, neck and ears for their P.E Lessons, break and lunch times.

During School:

- We will encourage the students to stay in the shade during playtime and lunch.
- Pupils will be encouraged to have their water bottles in the classroom and will be encouraged to drink at regular intervals. There are a number of water fountains in school where students can re-fill bottles at break or lunch.
- During P.E classes children will be allowed to wear their sun hats and take out their water bottles.

As sport day is taking place on Monday 19th June for Years 1, 2 &3 and the weather is forecasted to be 30C, please ensure that your child is provided with a sun hat and sunscreen.
