Year 2 trip to Ruislip Lido



We are planning to take the children in year two to Ruislip Lido, near Ruislip. This visit will help develop their knowledge and understanding of the world.

Wednesday 21 st June	2 Apricot and 2 Cherry
Thursday 22 nd June	2Peach and 2 Guava

The children will need to arrive in school at **8.45 a.m.** (we will not be able to wait for late-comers) and we expect to be back by the end of the school day but this very much depends on traffic. Children should wear school uniform and sensible walking shoes (no sandals). If it is expected to be a hot day please make sure your child has a hat and is wearing sunscreen. Please bring a swimming costume and a towel (& sun hat) as there is a beach there. If the weather is sunny on the day we can apply sunscreen lotion to protect your child. We can only do this if you tick the slip below to give us permission. Children will not need to bring any money on the day.

They will need a sensible packed lunch. **Please provide your child with a big enough bag to contain their swimming items and lunch; this is so they can walk around with ease.** Children who are entitled to Free School Meals can be provided with a grab bag. **Please see your child’s teacher to make sure one is ordered, if required, by**

Also, if your child suffers from travel sickness, give him/her a sickness tablet in the morning and if necessary hand another to the teacher for the return journey (in a named envelope).

This trip is part of The Park Federations ‘Childhood Promise’. Therefore you will not be required to pay, as the school will fund the entire trip. Please sign and return the slip below giving permission for your child to attend by **19th June.**
