Dear Parent,

Re: Swimming

An important part of the National Curriculum is that children are given the chance to learn to swim and develop confidence in water. This is a requirement of law and every child will need to attend unless there is medical evidence to support non-attendance. In order for us to fulfil this requirement, I have arranged for our Year 4 children to undertake a 10 week course in swimming at Montem Sports Centre in Slough. Separate changing facilities are provided for boys and girls.

Sessions will take place once a week on:

4 Ebony	Tuesday 19 th September to 28 th November 10.30am - 11.30am
4 Sycamore	Thursday 21 st September to 30 th November 13.30 - 14.30

The weekly outlay for each child is in excess of £7. Therefore, we are charged **£70** per child for the complete course. The school has paid for the pool hire and swimming instruction but we ask for a contribution of £2 towards the cost of transport. The total cost to parents is **£20**.

As the school has to pay in advance, we would like, if possible, your contribution of £20 in one lump sum as soon as possible, latest being Friday 15th September.

No children are allowed in the pool without a swim hat, naturally they will all require a swimsuit / trunks and a towel.

I look forward to your co-operation in this matter, however if you would like to discuss any aspects with me, please make an appointment at the school office or via your child's teacher. Please return the reply slip below as soon as possible.
