Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to welcome you back to what promises to be another exciting school year at Montem Academy! Last year, was a very productive year at Montem. The School Council arranged three family trips, which were well received and we were delighted to “bring home” the first ever Park Federation Young Musician of the Year trophy.

As a school, our SATs results in Key stage 1 and in Key Stage 2 continue to be in line with the national average. However, as a school we recognise the need to improve our reading results. Being a confident reader at a young age is key to future success. Therefore, the school will be introducing a range of strategies to support reading and reading across the curriculum, in order to promote a love of reading.

We are incredibly excited about the forthcoming year, as we believe that it promises to be filled with even more golden opportunities for all of our children as we strive to find ways that we can be even better than we have before! As we begin this new year, we aim to provide learning experiences that are engaging, meaningful and memorable, whilst ensuring that all children reach their full potential. We will therefore be:

- providing a wider range of extra-curricular activities.
- providing pupils with more opportunities to work within the wider community.
- Securing (within the next few weeks) our own mini bus so that we can provide our pupils with a wider range of learning experiences.

Last year, there were a number of exciting and significant changes at Montem. I am delighted to inform you that further changes continued during the Summer Holiday with extensive improvements being carried out to school building and grounds. It is the aim of Montem Academy to provide our children with an excellent learning environment which will have a positive impact on their learning, physical development and well-being. These improvements included:

- New vinyl flooring in the KS2 Main Hall: **£8,500**
- New Roof on KS1 Building: **£190,000**
- Mediterranean Garden reading, learning and al fresco eating area: **£11,000**

I would personally like to say a very big thank you to our Site Team who worked throughout the summer to ensure that the school was ready and looking at its best for the pupils on their first day back. These improvements and the investments made in these projects, demonstrates the Park Federation’s commitment to providing the children and families of Montem Academy with a first class learning environment.

In additional to these improvements, we have also purchased resources to support the teaching and learning in the classroom. These include:

- “Singapore Maths” resources for Year 4 : **£5,000**
- “Read, Write Inc” spelling resources: **£4,000**
- Headstart Comprehension resources: **£1,000**
- Guided reading books: **£5,000**
- “Birthday” books: **£1,500**

During this academic year, we will continue to build upon and refine our foundation of good work and look forward to a very positive and productive year together! We extend a special, yearlong invitation to our parents to join us at school activities and events whenever you can. Because we value your involvement and support, we will be continuing the ‘Welcome Wednesday’ initiative. Welcome Wednesday’s will continue to provide you with the opportunity to come in to school to watch a lesson being taught to your child. In addition to this, the school will be providing parent workshops to demonstrate to you how you can help support your child at home.

Please also know that we highly value home/school communication here at Montem Academy. It is vital and plays an integral role in each student’s success. Please do not hesitate to contact us if/when the need arises. We will do likewise. We want and encourage our parents to be actively involved and to be well informed in their child’s education.
