Uniform policy and jewellery

I have noticed that more and more children are wearing inappropriate school uniform items and jewellery.

Please note that the only earrings that are suitable for school, for health and safety reasons, are studs. Hoops and dangly earrings are not allowed.

With regards to headbands and scarves, these should be in dark plain colours only, such as grey, navy, black, blue. Large hair bows are not allowed.

Trainers should be plain, with no branding or logos, and if leggings are worn for PE they should be plain and of a dark colour.

When children are doing PE or sports clubs, they should wear their school sweatshirt or jumper. If they don't have one and need to wear a hoodie of their own, it should not be worn inside school at all. This includes in class, corridors or the canteen.
