- Addition, subtraction, multiplication (2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables) and division (including 1/2 and 1/4 of numbers). As well as number problems, you should also help your child with word problems for these four operations.
- Basic tables and graphs (bar graphs and pictograms) and tally charts.
- Identifying 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.
- Missing number sequences and number problems.

Reading

The Reading tests will not test your child pronunciation of reading speed; instead it will be a test of understanding and answering questions by finding evidence in the text.

The two tests for reading:

The 'exceeding age related' test will consist of two booklets; one booklet will be the text and the second will have the questions for the text. The questions will also be more about 'reading between the lines' as opposed to finding evidence.
