PROJECT 1

Have a go at writing your own version of a Greek Mythological story. Read some Greek Myths on the internet for ideas to help you. Remember to use powerful adjectives, adverbs and similes. Think about the beginning, middle and end. If you would like to make your story authentic why not stain it with tea bags or coffee.



PROJECT 2

Design and make your very own Greek pot. Think about the colours and materials you are going to use. This could be using coloured paper, coloured card or even pieces of coloured plastic. Take the time to research different Greek pots on the internet where there are also many designs available. Make sure you plan your design before you start.



PROJECT 3

Your task is to create the model of The Greek Amphitheatre. You can use wood or cardboard for this, as well as paper maché or newspaper. Use the internet to research what the theatre looked like during the Greek times. Please write a short paragraph to go with your model explaining what the theatre was used for.



PROJECT 4

Use a computer to research the Greek Olympics and modern day Olympics. Think about why they were important and how they are similar and different. You can use Microsoft PowerPoint, Publisher or Word to create your very own Olympics fact file.



PROJECT 5

Dr Who would like to go back in time. You decide which civilisation he should go to, the Romans or the Greeks. Think about all the facts and why each empire is still remembered today.
