RE: Year 4 – Go Ape

We are planning to take the children in Year 4 to Go Ape, Black Park in Uxbridge. This trip is a tree-top adventure which builds team-work and confidence. It will also give children another perspective of the forest which ties in nicely to our Science topic on Habitats. During the second part of the day, children will get the chance to explore different woodland habitats as well as investigate the wildlife that lives in the forest. The dates are as follows:

The children will need to arrive in school at **8.30 a.m.** (we will not be able to wait for late-comers) and we expect to be back by the end of the school day but this very much depends on traffic. Children will not need to bring any money on the day.

Children will need:

- A packed lunch with extra water
- Suitable clothing for climbing activities
- We suggest that they wear something you don't mind getting grubby.
- Dress for the weather so pack or wear a mac if it's raining! We will still do the course if it is wet!
- Appropriate footwear with soles with good grips. **No sandals or slip-off shoes.**
- Long hair must be tied back.
- A bag/sac perhaps with extra clothes in bad weather
- Sunblock and/or sun hat in hot weather

Children who are entitled to Free School Meals can be provided with a grab bag. Please tick the box on the slip to make sure one is ordered, if required, by Wednesday 13th June 2018. Also, if your child suffers from travel sickness, give him/her a sickness tablet in the morning and if necessary hand another to the teacher for the return journey (in a named envelope).

This trip is part of The Park Federation's 'Childhood Promise'. Therefore you will not be required to pay, as the school will fund the entire trip. Please sign and return the slip below giving permission for your child to attend by Wednesday 13th June 2018.

Children without written permission by Wednesday 13th June will not be able to attend the visit.
